BERNAT BIG BOX KNIT PULLOVER | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat® **Beyond**™ (4.2 oz/120 g; 80 yds/73 m)

Sizes XS/S XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Quartz Pink (23006) 15 16 17 18 22 balls 20

Sizes U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) and U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles or size **needed to obtain gauge.** 2 stitch holders.

ABBREVIATIONS:

RS = Right side Beg = Begin(ning)K = Knit**Cont** = Continue(ity) $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$ **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **Dec** = Decrease(ing) **Rem** = Remain(ing) **WS** = Wrong Side

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm] 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm] 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm] 44-46" [112-117 cm] 2/3 XL 48-54" [122-137 cm] 4/5 XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust

XS/S 42" [106.5 cm] 44" [112 cm] 47" [119.5 cm] XL 50" [127 cm] 2/3 XL 57" [145 cm] 4/5 XL 64" [162.5 cm]

GAUGE

9 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in garter st. 10 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

BACK

**With larger needles, cast on 53 (55-59-63-73-81) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing for 6" [15 cm], ending on a 2nd row and dec 4 (4-4-4-6-6) sts evenly across last row. 49 (51-55-59-67-75) sts.**

Proceed in garter st (knit every row), noting first row is RS, until work from beg measures 24 (241/2-25-25-26-261/2)" [61 (62-**63.5-63.5-66-67.5**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shoulders and back neck: Cast off 15 (16-17-19-23-27) sts. K19 (19-21-21-21) and leave these sts on a st holder. Cast off rem 15 (16-17-19-23-27) sts.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Proceed in garter st (knit every row), noting first row is RS, until workfrom beg measures 21 (21½-22-23-23½)" [53.5 (54.5-56-56-58.5-60) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: Next row: (RS). K20 (21-22-24-28-32) (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then on following RS rows 3 times more. **15** (16-17-19-23-27) sts rem.

Cont even until work from beg measures same length as Back to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

With RS facing, slip next **9** (9-11-11-11) sts onto a st holder. Rejoin yarn to rem sts and knit to end of row.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 2 rows, then on following RS rows 3 times more. **15** (16-17-19-23-27) sts rem.

Cont even until work from beg measures same length as Back to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on **27** (27-29-33-35-37) sts.

Work 2" [5 cm] in garter st (knit every row), noting first row is WS.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st for 4 rows. Inc 1 st each end of next and following 4th rows until there are 41 (43-45-47-47-49) sts.

Cont even until Sleeve from beg measures 15 (15-15-14-14-14)" [38 (38-38-35.5-35.5-35.5) cm], ending on a purl row and dec 3 sts evenly across last row. 38 (40-42-44-44-46) sts. Place markers at each end of last row.

Work a further 2" [5 cm] in garter st (knit every row) from marked row, ending on a RS row. Cast off loosely knitways (WS).

FINISHING

Collar: Sew right shoulder seam.
With RS facing and larger needles, pick up and knit 14 sts down left front neck edge. K9 (9-11-11-11-11) from Front st holder, inc 3 sts evenly across. Pick up and knit 14 sts up right front neck edge.
K19 (19-21-21-21-21) from Back st holder, inc 4 sts evenly across.
63 (63-67-67-67) sts.

Next row: (WS). Knit.

Beg on a 1st row, work in (K1. P1) ribbing as given for Back for 12" [30.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Cast off loosely in ribbing.

Sew left shoulder and Collar seam.

Place markers on side edges of Back and Front 8 (8½-9-9½-9½-10)" [20.5 (21.5-23-24-24-25.5) cm] down from shoulders. Sew in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.
