



## MATERIALS

Patons® Iced™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 85 yds/77 m)

Sizes	XS/S	M	L	XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	
Fog (97007)	7	8	9	10	12	14	<b>balls</b>

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles. Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 4 stitch markers. 3 buttons 1" [2.5 cm] diameter.

<b>2/3 X-Large</b>	48-54" [122-137 cm]
<b>4/5 X-Large</b>	56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

## GAUGE

11 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.  
 9½ sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## BODY

**Note:** Body is worked in one piece to armholes.

With circular needle, cast on **96** (**104-114-126-140-156**) sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:  
 Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. \*yo. K2tog. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

Rep last row for pat until work from beg measures 18½" [47 cm], ending on a WS row.

**Divide for armholes: Next row:** Pat across **22** (**24-24-26-26-28**) sts (Right Front). Cast off **8** (**8-12-16-20-24**) sts. Pat

across **36** (**40-42-42-48-52**) sts (including st on needle after cast off) (Back). Cast off **8** (**8-12-16-20-24**) sts. Pat across **22** (**24-24-26-26-28**) sts (including st on needle after cast off). Leave Right Front and Back sts on circular needle.

**Left Front:** With pair of needles, cont in pat on last **22** (**24-24-26-26-28**) sts until armhole measures **9** (**9½-9½-10-10-10½**)" [**23** (**24.5-24.5-25.5-25.5-27**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise. Place marker on cast off edge **9** (**11-12-12-14-16**) sts in from side edge for shoulder.

**Back:** With WS facing and pair of needles, join yarn to **36** (**40-42-42-48-52**) sts and cont in pat until armhole measures same length as Left Front, ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise. Place markers on cast off edge **9** (**11-12-12-14-16**) sts in from each side edge for shoulders.

**Right Front:** With WS facing and pair of needles, join yarn to **22** (**24-24-26-26-28**) sts and cont in pat until armhole measures same length as Left Front, ending on a WS row.

Cast off knitwise. Place marker on cast off edge **9** (**11-12-12-14-16**) sts in from side edge for shoulder.

## SLEEVES

With pair of needles, cast on **28** (**28-28-30-30-30**) sts.

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

**1st row:** (RS). K1. \*yo. K2tog. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

Rep last row for pat until work from beg measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Keeping cont of pat, inc 1 st each end of next row and following **6th** (**4th-4th-4th-4th-4th**) rows until there are **44** (**34-34-38-38-46**) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

**Sizes M, L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:** Inc 1 st each end of following 6th rows until there are (**46-46-48-48-50**) sts, taking inc sts into pat.

**All sizes:** Cont even in pat until work from beg measures **17½** (**17½-17-16½-16-16**)" [**44.5** (**44.5-43-42-40.5-40.5**) cm], ending on a WS row. Place markers at each end of last row.

Work a further **4** (**4-8-10-12-14**) rows in pat. Cast off knitwise.

## FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew shoulder seams to markers. Sew in sleeves placing rows above markers along cast off sts of Body to form square armholes. Sew sleeve seams.

Place markers for 3 buttons on Left Front having top button approx 11" [28 cm] down from cast off edge, bottom button 5" [12.5 cm] above cast on edge and rem button spaced evenly between. Sew buttons in position noting buttonholes on Right Front will be created from openwork spaces in pat and allowing for approx 1¼" [3 cm] overlap. Allow Fronts to fold back into 'lapels' between top button and shoulder.
