



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Beg** = Beginning

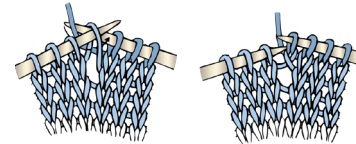
**Cont** = Continue

**Dec** = Decrease

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop



**MB** = [(K1. yo) twice. K1] all in next stitch. 5 sts. Turn. P5. Turn. K5. Turn. P2tog. P1. P2togtbl. 3 sts. Turn. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. 1 st remains. Bobble complete. Push Bobble to RS of work

**Pat** = Pattern

**P** = Purl

**PM** = Place marker

**P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches together

**P2togtbl** = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops

**Pssso** = Pass slipped stitch over

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sl1** = Slip next stitch knitwise

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

**Yo** = Yarn over

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Bundle Up™** (8.8 oz/250 g; 478 yds/437 m)

Sizes	6	12	18	24	mos
<b>Contrast A</b> Blue Dawn (44014)	1	1	1	1	ball
<b>Contrast B</b> Marshmallow (44001)	1	1	1	1	ball
<b>Contrast C</b> Misty Gray (44020)	1	1	1	1	ball

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" [40.5 cm] long. Set of 4 sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

## SIZES

**Finished chest measurement**

**6 mos** 17" [43 cm]

**12 mos** 18" [45.5 cm]

**18 mos** 19" [48 cm]

**24 mos** 20" [51 cm]

## GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st on larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus ( ). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Notes:** Garment is worked from neck edge down.

When working from chart, carry color not in use loosely across WS of work. The colors are never twisted around one another.

## SWEATER

**Neckband:** With A and smaller circular needle, cast on 80 sts. Join in rnd, PM on first st.

**1st to 8th rnds:** \*K2. P2. Rep from \* around.

Change to larger needle and proceed as follows:

Knit 2 rnds even.

**Next rnd:** \*K4. M1. Rep from \* around. 100 sts.

Work 1st rnd of Chart, reading rows from **right to left**, noting 10-st rep will be worked 10 times.

Cont working chart until all **25 (27-30-30)** rnds are complete, making note of increases in chart.

**(Note:** Tail is worked in Rnd 23 as bobble.) **170 (180-190-190)** sts.

**Size 24 mos only:** With A, knit 3 rnds.

**Next rnd:** \*K19. M1. Rep from \* around. 200 sts.

**All sizes:** With A, knit even in rnds until work after neckband measures **5 (5½-6-6½)" [12.5 (14-15-16.5) cm]**.

**Divide for Body and Sleeves:**

**1st rnd:** \*Slip next **34 (36-38-40)** sts onto scrap yarn for sleeve. Cast on **4 (6-6-6)** sts. K**51 (54-57-60)**. Rep from \* once more. **110 (120-126-132)** Body sts.

Knit even in rnds until work from divide measures **5 (6-7-8)" [12.5 (15-18-20.5) cm]**.

**Sizes 6 mos and 18 mos only:**

**Next rnd:** K2tog. K**53 (61)**. K2tog. Knit to end of rnd. **108 (124)** sts.

**All sizes:** With smaller needle, proceed as follows:

**1st to 8th rnds:** \*K2. P2. Rep from \* around.

Cast off in ribbing.

**Sleeves:** With set of 4 larger double-pointed needles, beg at center of underarm cast on sts, pick up and knit **2 (3-3-3)** sts. K**34 (36-38-40)** Sleeve sts. Pick up and knit **2 (3-3-3)** sts across rem underarm cast on sts. **38 (42-44-46)** sts. Join in rnd, PM on first st. Knit in rnds until Sleeve measures **2 (2½-3-3)" [5 (6.5-7.5-7.5) cm]**.

**Shape sleeves: Next (dec) rnd:** K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1. **36 (40-42-44)** sts.

**Next 5 (3-4-3) rnds:** Knit.

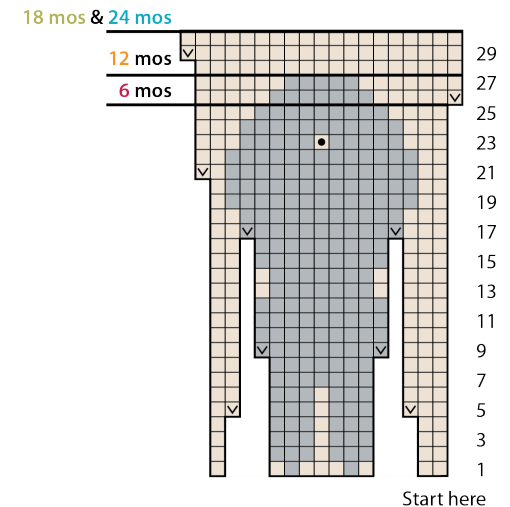
Rep these **6 (4-5-4) rnds 2 (4-3-4)** times more. **32 (32-36-36)** sts.

Knit even in rnds until Sleeve measures **5½ (6-6½-7)" [14 (15-16.5-18) cm]**.

Change to smaller double-pointed needles and proceed as follows:

**1st to 8th rnds:** \*K2. P2.

Rep from \* around. **5½ - 6 - 6½ - 7**  
Cast off in ribbing.
