



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc2tog = Yoh and draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches.

Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZES

Girl's Version

To fit chest measurement

2 **22"** [56 cm]

4 **24"** [61 cm]

6 **26"** [66 cm]

Woman's Version

To fit bust measurement

XS/S/M **28-36"** [71-91.5 cm]

2/3XL **38-46"** [96.5-117 cm]

4/5XL **48-62"** [122-157.5 cm]

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT

****Ribbing:** Ch **10** (**10-10-14-14-14**).

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **9** (**9-9-13-13-13**) sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Pop!™ (5 oz/140 g; 280 yds/256 m)

Sizes **2** **4** **6** **XS/S/M** **2/3XL** **4/5XL**

Snow Queen (84013) or **3** **3** **4** **6** **7** **8** **balls**
Birch Bark and Blue (84016)

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch markers. 4 buttons – 1" [2.5 cm] diameter.

Rep last row until work from beg (when slightly stretched) measures **18 (19-21-28-31-35)" [45.5 (48-53.5-71-78.5-89)** cm], ending on a WS row.

Do not fasten off.

Turn work sideways and proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Work **45 (49-53-73-81-89)** sc evenly across side of ribbing. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. Turn.

Last 2 rows form pat.**

Cont in pat until work from lower edge measures **14 (17-19-24-25-27)" [35.5 (43-48-61-63.5-68.5)** cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). Pat across **18 (20-21-29-32-36)** sts. Hdc2tog over next 2 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row. **16 (18-19-27-30-34)** sts rem.

Cont even in pat until work from lower edge measures **16 (19-21-27-28-30)" [40.5 (48-53.5-68.5-71-76)** cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

1st row: (RS). Skip next **5 (5-7-11-13-13)** sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st. Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). Hdc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row. **16 (18-19-27-30-34)** sts rem.

Cont even in pat until work from lower edge measures **16 (19-21-27-28-30)" [40.5 (48-53.5-68.5-71-76)** cm], ending on a WS row.

BACK

Rep from ** to ** as given for Front. Cont in pat until work from lower edge measures same length as Front to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Collar: Sew right shoulder seam. Ch **22 (22-24-30-30-30)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **21 (21-23-29-29-29)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures length to fit loosely around neck edge, ending on a WS row and sewing in position with ease as you work. Fasten off. Sew left shoulder and Collar seam.

Side ribbing:

Ch **8 (8-8-10-10-10)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **7 (7-7-9-9-9)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures length to fit along side edge of Poncho, ending on a WS row and sewing in position as you work. Fasten off.

Rep for opposite side. Sew 2 buttons on each side through all thicknesses.
